The United States government agency has been protecting human health and the environment since 1970. More than half of its 15,000 full-time employees are engineers, scientists, and specialists in need of high caliber workplace interior solutions. The Agency's Seattle office reached out to Egan with a request to enhance the work environment for their newly renovated offices.

The project scope involved systems furniture for a large open office that preserved the sense of vast space and allowed in plenty of light. To address workstation privacy, the client requested a mobile whiteboard that could also be used for wayfinding and messaging within departments. Egan Lite Screen Door is dry-erase friendly, guaranteed-to-clean, and nesting-capable with the existing systems furniture panel frames. As such, the mobile solution met all customer needs and they were very satisfied with the end result.

Egan Rep Bennett Associates worked through multiple complex contract issues to accommodate a 3 ½ year project schedule, and presented a straightforward solution: 600+ Egan Lite Screen Doors, Single Panel (VSD) with both sides specified in Egan Versa Presentation Surface (EVS™). The product is designed to rotate 360° around a unique weighted trip-free base with exceptional stability. A 90° notch in the base provides compatibility with any partition system. The no-lock front caster rolls smoothly and ensures the door will fold back to permit free traffic flow. Finally, the matte-white EVS surface is dry-erase compatible and guaranteed-to clean.
